

MOTION PLANNING & LAND USE MANAGEMENT

The Bicycle Advisory Committee was established prior to 1985 and has been serving the City for many years. In October 1985, the Council adopted a motion (Braude - Finn) to expand the participants in this Committee to include the involved Council District, Planning Department, Department of Public Works, Bureau of Engineering, and established the Department of Transportation as Chair.

It has become evident that there are certain structural and operational changes which must be made at this time in order to allow the Bicycle Advisory Committee to reach its full potential.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council approve the following changes to the Bicycle Advisory Committee:

- Will be jointly staffed by the Department of Transportation and the City Planning Department;
- A liaison from the Department of Recreation and Parks will be assigned to assist the committee as needed;
- Appoint an administrative staff person to be responsible to post meeting minutes, agendas, and other support services;
- Establish that any member of the Bicycle Advisory Committee may make a motion for the election of a new Chair; and that upon a majority vote of the members, an election for the Chair will be immediately held for a minimum term of one year; and
- Require each member to have an assigned alternate member.


I FURTHER MOVE that the Council request the Board of Public Works to assign a Commissioner to the Bicycle Advisory Committee.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council request the City Attorney to assign a City Attorney to attend all meetings of the Bicycle Advisory Committee.
